**RESOLUTION NO. 97-035**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 91-076 ADDING TO  
GUALALA MUNICIPAL ADVISORY  
COUNCIL POWERS**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 91-076, the Board of Supervisors established the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council to advise the Board of Supervisors on planning issues that affect or have the potential to affect the Gualala area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council has demonstrated to the Board of Supervisors its value in advising the Board on planning issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires to expand the area of responsibility of the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council to also include matters of public health, safety, welfare and public works; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 91-076 reserves the right to expand the powers of the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council and Government Code § 31010 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to expand the scope of advisory matters as specified above.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the powers of the Gualala Advisory Council are amended and restated to be as follows:

I. (a) Planning (Gualala Area)

1. Advise the Board of Supervisors on current and long term planning and development projects including amendments to the General Plan and Local Coastal Program.

2. Those elements or topics of the General Plan and Local Coastal Plan including, but not limited to, land use, circulation, parking, housing, seismic safety, safety, noise, open space, conservation and public access.

The highest priority of the Council shall be those issues concerning the completion or updating of the General Plan and Local Coastal Program which may be reimbursable through the State of California.

(b) Public Health, Safety, Welfare and Public Works (Gualala Area)

The first priority of the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council is the planning advisory function in (a) above. The Gualala Municipal Advisory Council may also advise the Board of Supervisors, as the need arises, on matters of public health, safety, welfare and public works.

II. The Gualala Municipal Advisory Council may represent the Gualala Community to any federal, state, county, city, special district, agency or commission, or any other organization for any matter under I(a) and (b) above. Such representation shall be by resolution. Any such resolution must begin with:

"Whereas, the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council was established to advise the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors on planning issues and matters of public health, safety, welfare and public works; and

Whereas, resolutions of the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council do not necessarily represent the opinion of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors; and"

III. Copies of all resolutions adopted by the Gualala Municipal Advisory Council shall be sent to the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors.

Matters regarding geographic jurisdiction, membership, budgeting and staffing shall continue to be governed by Resolution No. 91-076.
